

Terms and conditions for participating in Ambassador for a Day British Embassy The Hague

The initiative is open to female applicants – whose prime country of residence is the Netherlands and who are aged between 15-18 years on 21 January 2025.

There is **no entry fee**.

The British Embassy The Hague will cover the reasonable travel expenses for the winners and, in case of a winner under the age of 18, one chaperone per winner.

Route to entry:

- All candidates must answer the following question: *If you were Ambassador for a Day, how would you campaign for gender equality?*
- The entries should be in the format of a video blog no longer than 2 minutes. The video can be in English or Dutch;
- Candidates must complete and submit an <u>application form</u>
- Candidates must send their video through a Wetransfer link, to <u>embassywebsite@gmail.com.</u> 'My entry to the A4D initiative' must be in the subject line. Candidates' full name must be in the email and in the video file name.
- Candidates must enter the competition with a video, which has not been published prior to the announcement of the Ambassador for a Day competition and have not been used for applying to similar initiatives.

Only one entry will be accepted per person. Multiple entries from the same person will be disqualified.

The estimated number of successful applicants will be between two and four. However, the British Embassy reserves the right to amend this according to the number of applications. This decision will be made at the discretion of the Embassy.

Closing date for entry will be 17:00 hrs, 21 January 2025. After this date, no further entries will be permitted.

No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason. With regards to the successful applicants, the British Embassy will be seeking consent (including parental consent if the applicant is under the age of 18) in respect of the following:

 The winners agree to be photographed and/or filmed during public and online engagements within the Ambassador for a Day campaign in order to promote the initiative, provided that the photos/videos do not prejudice their dignity and reputation;



• If under 18 years old on the day of the visit, winners have the right to bring a chaperone, who is over 18 years old (parent, teacher, or guardian) in order to travel to The Hague. This is not obligatory.

The British Embassy's decision in respect of all matters to do with the initiative, including but not limited to the appraisal of the participants, the organisation of the initiative and the programme of the day for the successful applicants, will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. The embassy shall have the right to change the dates and order shall a necessity occur, whereby the participants shall be notified.

By entering this initiative, the entrant and her lawful representative is indicating her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
